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# IMD Prediction

- India is expected to receive above-average rainfall in 2025, with projections at 105% of the long-term average of 868m.
- The absence of El Niño conditions and the potential development of La Niña later in the season are contributing to the positive monsoon outlook.
- While most regions are likely to experience above-normal rainfall, certain areas in northwest, northeast, and southern Peninsular.



- Skymet forecasts a normal monsoon in 2025, with rainfall at 103% of the long-term average, plus or minus 5%.
- The forecast is supported by neutral El Niño–Southern Oscillation (ENSO) conditions and a potentially positive Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD).
- The monsoon is likely to reach Kerala around May 31 and The anticipated good monsoon is expected to boost agricultural output, stabilize food prices, and support economic growth

India has produced approximately 254.97 lakh tonnes of sugar, with around 38 sugar mills still operational as of April 15, Indian Sugar and Bioenergy Manufacturers Association said in a statement Thursday.

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 Around 35 lakh tons of sugar is expected to be diverted towards ethanol production this year, against last year's estimated diversion of 21.5 lakh tonnes.
